

Safety Requirements - Best Lap 2024

1. Main clauses

- 1.1 The Organizer on the competition is Hobby Racing MTÜ (80577392).
- 1.2 Following rules and safety requirements are mandatory for all registered Participants of Best Lap.
- 1.3 The Participant is fully responsible for the compliance of the obligations and prohibitions of the track and possible consequences for non-compliance.
- 1.4 By executing the registration Participant with his signature confirms and accepts all the safety requirement and regulations of Best Lap and agrees to follow and comply them.
- 1.5 Participants are obliged to comply with all noise limits and requirements set by track operators.

2. Safety requirements

- 2.1 The driver is obligated to use the seatbelt (-belts).
- 2.2 The driver is obligated to wear head protective helmet with «E» certificate, long-sleeved protective clothing, long pants, closed shoes and gloves.
- 2.3 All items inside the vehicle should be securely fastened and must not endanger the persons in the vehicle.
- 2.4 Each vehicle should be equipped with fire extinguisher with a valid period control. The capacity of the fire extinguisher should be at least 1 kg, it must be securely fixed in the vehicle and be easily accessible for the Driver.
- 2.5 Drivers intoxicated with alcohol or drugs are now allowed to competition.
- 2.6 It is forbidden to carry out any repair works on the track. Repair works are allowed in pit-boxes or in the parking lot.
- 2.7 Rules of behaviour on the event aera
 - 2.7.1 Maximum speed level in the parking lot and pit-lane zone is 20 km/h.
 - 2.7.2 Intentional drift and loud tire heating up is forbidden.
 - 2.7.3 Parents are responsible for the safety and behaviour of their children.
 - 2.7.4 More detailed rules depending on the track and are provided in the bulletin of each stage.

3. Participant responsibility

- 3.1 Participant is fully responsible for any damage being caused to his health or his property, as well as the damage being caused by his action or inaction to the property, life and health of the third parties.
- 3.2 Any damage being caused to the venue of the competition (incl. Inventory that belongs to the Organizers) by action or inaction of the Participant must be fully compensated to the Organizers of the competition.
- 3.3 All the disputes regarding damage caused to the venue of the competition will be considered through mutual negotiations in the first place and if the parties will not reach agreement within 30 days the further consideration will take place in Court.



- 3.4 If Participant refuses to comply instructions and decisions of the Organizer, the Organizer has right to exclude Participant from competition. This prohibition has no time limits and can be changed at any time by the decision of Organizer.
- 3.5 The Participant must understand that taking part of the competition might be associated with potential risks to life and health.
- 3.6 The Participant undertakes not to submit any demands and claims to the Organizers of the event concerning caused damages, injuries or other type of damage being caused during the competition.
- 3.7 Alcohol test might be performed during the Competition. Alcohol test might be executed with alcohol meter. In case of exceeding of permitted level (0,2 ppm in exhaled air) or in case of refusing to pass the test, Participant will be excluded from Competition.
- 3.8 During the training sessions passengers are allowed to sit in the vehicle next to the driver. Same rules and requirements as for the drivers are applied to the passengers.
- 3.9 Participants are fully responsible for life and health of the passengers in their vehicles during the training sessions and races.
- 3.10 Participant confirms that he has read rules and requirements, understands them clearly and undertakes to comply.

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
