



## Additional regulations of the 1st stage of Best Lap 2020 competition at Tabasalu Kadirada 13.06.2020

The regulations listed below, are additional to the general rules of the BestLap amateur competitions.

1. The first stage of the BestLap amateur competition will take place at Tabasalu Kadirada, Harku-Rannamõisa tee, Harku vald, 76922 Harjumaa on the 13th of June 2020, [www.kadirada.ee/](http://www.kadirada.ee/)
2. Online registration for the event will start from 13.05.2020 on the official web page [www.bestlap.ee](http://www.bestlap.ee). All information, including safety requirements, technical data and main regulations is available on the official web page of the event [www.bestlap.ee](http://www.bestlap.ee).
3. Any vehicle that meets technical data requirements is allowed to participate in BestLap amateur competition.
4. Participation fee: 50 euro per Participant in case of online pre-registration and 60 euro on the day of the event.
  - 4.1 Pre-registration fee should be transferred to the event Organizer bank account. Pre-registration fee payment deadline is on 11.05.2020, 23:59.
  - 4.2 Please mark in the clarification field the name of the Participant name and Stage number, for example „**Stage 1, Bugs Bunny**“.
  - 4.3 Registration activates and Participant gets the place in the start list only after the payment was executed.
  - 4.4 Please note, that the participation fee is not refundable in case of the Participant's absence on the day of the competition or non-compliance of safety requirements (excluding conditions mentioned in p.10)
  - 4.5 To be able to participate in competition, Participant must have a valid driving licence. If Participant is younger than 18 y.o. then valid driving licence must have his accompanying adult.
5. After registration at the place the Participant will receive a starting number and advertising stickers. Starting number must be fixed to the back side windows of the car. Advertising stickers must be fixed on places specified by Organizer. Information about the the stickers location will be given with stickers.

7. Event description and start order :
  - 7.1 Start according to the Start list. Start list will be published on the information stand on the day of the competition and also on the webpage <http://www.bestlap.ee>
  - 7.2 During one race Participant should drive 7 laps, from which: 1 warming-up lap, 5 combat laps, 1 cooling-off lap.
  - 7.3 Up to five vehicles are allowed to the track at the same time. Time measure starts at the Start/Finish line.
  - 7.4 While moving to the Start line Participants will be able to warm up their vehicles and tires.
  - 7.5 Start will be given by the judge permission, by raising the starting flag or by traffic signal.
  - 7.6 Each Participant will have 5 laps to show his best lap time.
  - 7.7 The fastest Participant gets 1 point, the second one gets 2 points and so on, until all the Participants reach the finish line and gets their points.
  - 7.8 In total there are 3 races during one stage. The smallest sum of the two best attempts gives the final result of the stage. In case of the same number of points in the same class Participant who showed the best time of the lap on the day of the event wins. If the best lap time number are equal Participant who showed the second best time wins.
  - 7.9 Overtaking during the competition is forbidden. It is allowed only in case if the front slow-moving vehicle shows the turn signal and snuggles to the edge of the road. In all other cases you might be disqualified and the result of the race will not be counted.
  - 7.10 If the slower pilot in front of you does not let you through and you are not able execute the overtake, you will be allowed to redo the race.
  - 7.11 If the driver is more then 3 min late for the start (or to the warm-up lap), he loses the right to participate in the particular race.
  - 7.12 Failor to obey the orders of the Organizers and Judges will lead to disqualification and expulsion from the event.
  - 7.13 At any time of the event (from registration untill award ceremony) all vehicles must fully comply with requirements of technical regulations.
8. Award ceremony:
  - 8.1 The first three places of each stage will be awarded by the end of the stage. If the quantity of participants in the class is less than 5, only the 1st place will be awarded.
  - 8.2 Sponsors and event Organizers might also provide additional awards.
9. The minimum number of participants is 25. In case of not reaching the minimum number of participants the event will be cancelled. In case of cancellation Organizers will return the participation fees to the participants. Information about cancellation of the event will be announced at least 24 hours in prior.
- 10. If the event will be cancelled due to the extension of the emergency state in Estonia or other reasons related to the epidemy of the coronavirus COVID-19, participation fees will be returned to the participants. Posponed or new event date will be announced later.**
11. Participants are fully responsible for any damage being caused to them or their property, life and health and also responsible for the damage of property, life and health of the third parties.
